- Ease financial pressure on parents.

- Enhance health and safety of students when involved in school activities.

### Our Uniform

School uniform to be worn Monday, Tuesday and Thursday. Sports shirt to be worn on Wednesday and Friday.

Sport Polo Shirt – Navy Blue. Faction colours Red, Green, Gold or Blue
Surf Collar Navy Blue
Girls Skort – Skirt/Short - Navy Blue
Rugger Board Shorts with Side and Back Pockets
Unisex Cargo Shorts - Navy
1/4 Zip Navy Polar fleece Jumper with pockets

### What Can Be Worn if You Don’t Have Uniform

- Clothes that match as closely as possible to the school uniform colours.
- White or blue plain top, Navy shorts or track pants.

### Appropriate Items Other Than Clothing

- Watches
- Necklaces (small and unobtrusive)
- Studs or sleepers
- Small scrunchies

### Hair Styles

- Hair must be kept neat at all times and appropriate hair styles worn.
- Head lice are a problem in all schools and maintaining neat, well-kept hair can assist in managing this issue.
- Students wearing in appropriate hairstyles can be precluded from school photos.

### Expectations

- Parents will support the dress code
- Staff will support the dress code
- All students will wear the school uniform.
- Students on excursions or representing the school at carnivals will wear the school uniform.

### Following our Dress Code

- The school will follow up on dress code issues using both formal and informal processes as outlined below.

Informal - teachers discussing one-off dress issues with students.

Formal - students who repeatedly do not adhere to the dress code will report to administration, letter sent to parents seeking their support.

### If Dress Code is Not Followed

- Students may be required to exchange clothes for appropriate wear available from lost property or uniform shop.
- Students may be excluded from excursions, school photos, sporting events or other outings where they represent the school.

### Exemptions

- At the principal’s discretion an exemption from wearing the uniform can be granted if sufficient reasons warrant this.
