2018 Kindy and Pre-Primary

KINDY 2018

Applications are now open for Kindy 2018. Children born between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014 are eligible to attend Kindy in 2018.

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Children born between 1 July 2013 and 30 June 2014 are eligible to attend Kindy in 2018.

Application can be downloaded from website or by visiting the school office. Please complete the application and return to the school office with the following supporting documents with application:

- Confirmation of address in the form of one of the following:

- Utility bill (electricity, gas, water)
- Lease Agreement
- Council Rate notice

(Confirmation of address must be current, and of at least 3 months)

- Birth Certificate
- Immunisation History Printout Details (medicare or via mygov)
- Visa and Passports (if applicable)

(Application forms may be left without supporting documentation, though are still a requirement).

We encourage all parents to submit their applications before the end of Term 2 – (30th June 2017). Applications close Friday 21st July 2017, first week of Term 3.

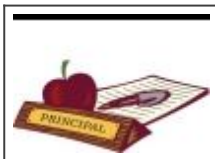
Please note that an application does not confirm a child's placement - selection criteria do apply. We will notify all applicants in writing during term 3 (approx end August 2017) the outcome of their application.

PRE-PRIMARY 2018

Parents of students that are currently enrolled in our 2017 Kindy classes, applications for Pre-Primary 2018 will be sent home in Term 3. At this time we will also be asking for you to provide your child's 4 year old Immunisation History Printout.

Principal's Word - 19th May 2017

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Whenever new students commence school I meet with the family. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss school expectations and provide an understanding of how we need to work together to get the best out of their child or children. My first words are about relationships and how important they are. For a child to have success at school parents and the school must work together, discussing any concerns and support each other in what is best for the child's education. I then discuss how important it is for the child to inform a staff member if they are having an issue with their learning or other students. Too often, we have parents coming up claiming their child has been teased or hurt and yet, at school, we have no knowledge of it. Encourage your child to speak to a staff member so we can support them and resolve the issue, which enables them to become more empowered.

At Safety Bay, our focus is the child, as our motto states, "Putting Children First". To do that successfully, we need your support. Let's work together.

Obstacle Course Event

Next Friday, May 26, the P&C will hold the Annual Obstacle Course Event which is the major fundraising for the year. Last year over \$29 000 was raised by the team which enabled the school to purchase ipads, air conditioners for the Kindergarten and assist for student transport to Year 6 Camp. This year's focus is to enable funding for an upgrade to playground areas, including shade in the Pre Primary.

Parent helpers on the day are vital and the more who can volunteer (even for an hour), the better. This enables parents to watch their own children participate and yet support the P&C. Another way to support is to assist your child with dressing up as a part of a team. The idea is for the students to make up teams and help each other through the course. Older students will be working with younger students through the

obstacles, which is a really positive part of the day. It is not a race, as such but an opportunity for the children to complete the course together and have fun while doing it. Parents are also welcome to come along and watch and encourage their child in participating.

National Assessment Program Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN)

Last week the Year 3 and 5 students undertook the NAPLAN Testing (unless they were exempted) in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions (Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation) and Numeracy. The data from NAPLAN test results gives schools and systems the ability to compare their students' achievements against national standards and with student achievement in other states and territories. It also allows the monitoring of student progress over time.

As a school we also tested our students in Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6 to enable us to check progress and ascertain areas of concern. It enables teachers to plan for improvement and we can also compare progress of students from year to year.

Parents of students in Years 3 and 5 will receive a full report on your child's progress around September.

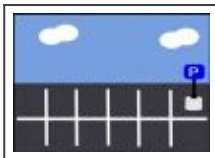
Kindergarten and Pre Primary Enrolments

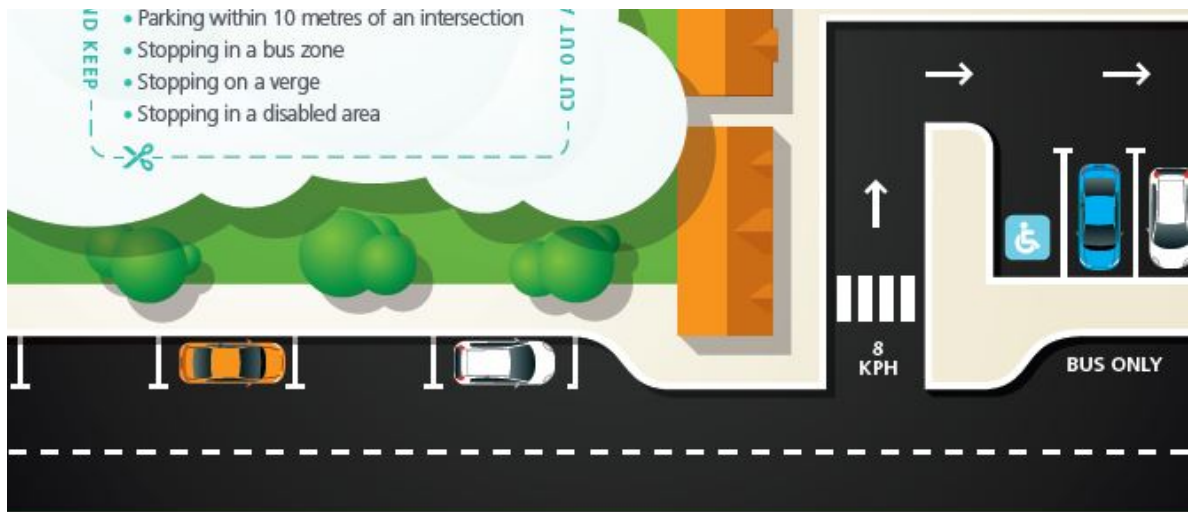

We are starting to source some materials for building the instruments, and would be very grateful to accept donations from individuals or businesses that may have leftovers or offcuts to donate. The following materials will be of use:

- PVC pipe of larger diameters – 50mm to 90mm
- Steel tubing – 50/60mm square or round
- Hardwood timber lengths – Jarrah floorboards (not decking timber) and

2" x 4" lengths

- Exterior paints/ spray paints suitable for galvanised or PVC surfaces
- Aluminium tubing of different diameters

- Polyethylene pipe 50 – 80mm
- Steel cable, light weight
- Marine Ply Sheets
